

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

VIT INTERNATIONAL WARMIŃSKO-MAZURSKI VOCAL MASTERCLASS WITH ELEMENTS OF ANATOMY, PHYSIOLOGY AND VOICE HYGIENE, WITH PRACTICAL APPLICATION IN A PERFORMANCE CONTEXT.

The Course is organized by: Department of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Diseases UWM, Faculty of Arts UWM-Institute of Music UWM in cooperation with the Foundation for Development of Vocalism and Professional Voice Prevention "Voice&Med Arts" and Center for Artistic Initiatives UWM.

The Course is under the Honorary Patronage of:

The aim of the Course is to improve skills and deepen vocal technique and knowledge of anatomy, physiology, and voice hygiene. The Course is dedicated particularly to singers struggling with various health problems that translate into functional voice disorders and professional singers who for various reasons have "lost" proper vocal technique. The charming location in Warmia will allow distancing from everyday problems and focus on the set goal in the beautiful and historically rich areas of Lidzbark Warmiński.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The course will take place from September 08-12, 2025, in Lidzbark Warmiński. Classes will be held at the Orangery of Culture / Municipal Pedagogical Library, Lidzbark Cultural Center, Krasicki Castle and the Pilgrim House.

The Course is open to students of last year of studies and graduates of high school vocal classes, students and graduates of music universities, professional singers and singing teachers.

Active participants are guaranteed at least 5 lessons, selected quantitatively and individually according to participant needs:

- lessons with Maestra Agnieszka Rehlis
- lessons with **prof. dr. Zdzisław Madej**
- lesson with **dr hab. Hanna Zajączkiewicz, prof. UWM**, including breathing technique and participant's health problems.

The organizers reserve the right to individualize the course participants according to their technical sophistication, voice type and vocal skills. The above criteria will be the basis for possible individualization of the participant's course of work in the performance context.

The participants will work with accompanists **Katarzyna Neugebauer** and **Łukasz Dębski**.

The Course includes panel discussions for participants on anatomy, physiology and voice hygiene. In addition, there will be workshops conducted by specialists:

- Monika Kozlowska psychologist, Mindfullnes teacher and TRE method therapist (Tension & Trauma Releasing Exercises). TRE is a body work method developed by Dr. David Berceli that involves activating natural neurogenic tremors to release deeply rooted tension and stress – both physical and emotional.
- **Grzegorz Lemiesz** physiotherapist who specializes in a holistic approach to health, evaluating the entire body as an integral whole, as well as broadly defined musculoskeletal dysfunction in the context of the voice.

Sheet music in PDF format (maximum of four arias and one opera part) should be sent to <u>kontakt@voicemedarts.com</u> after the candidate qualifies, no later than September 4, 2025.

A *Concert of opera arias and songs* is planned during the Course at the Orangery of Culture on **September 11, 2025, at 6:00 PM**.

The organizers reserve the right to record the concerts and publish photos and recordings of the concert and the Course.

APPLICATION

An application for the Course is understood as sending a clearly scanned or photographed, correctly filled-in Application Form with attachments to <u>kontakt@voicemedarts.com</u> by September 1, 2025.

A correctly filled-in Application Form should include: the candidate's personal and contact details, a list of pieces the participant would like to work on, and personally signed declarations.

Required attachments to the application are: a link to one recording of an opera/oratorio aria performed by the candidate in audio or video format, a short resume, and a recent photo.

Eligibility for the Course is decided by the pedagogues in charge after listening to the submitted recordings, considering the order of submission.

Candidates, on qualification for the Course, will be notified individually, **no later than**September 2, 2025. The decision on qualification for the Course is final.

FEES

The fee for active participation in the Course is **1500 PLN**.

The fee for **active participation** in the Course includes:

- 5 individual singing lessons with pedagogues and a pianist,
- detailed, methodical discussion of participant's vocal problems,
- lectures and talks on psychology, voice methodology and voice hygiene,
- group and individual sessions (for interested participants) with psychologist,
- individual sessions with physiotherapist,
- concert participation,
- course completion certificate,
- lunches during the Course.

Accommodation and other meals are arranged by participants themselves. Help with finding accommodation is available.

The fee for **passive participation** in the Course is **250 PLN** (or 50 PLN for 1 day).

The organizers are not responsible for lost personal items, money or documents.
